PM Modi inaugurates 6th edition of Raisina Dialogue

Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurate the 6th edition of the Raisina Dialogue through a video message on 13 April virtually, along with Chief Guests- Prime Minister of Denmark, Mette Frederiksen and the President of Rwanda, Paul Kagame.

The Raisina Dialogue is India's flagship conference on geopolitics and geo-economics, under the theme for the 2021 Edition is "#ViralWorld: Outbreaks, Outliers and Out of Control" was jointly organised by the Ministry of External Affairs and the Observer Research Foundation from 13-16 April, 2021.

Prime Minister Modi observed that the current edition of the Raisina Dialogue was taking place at a watershed moment in human history in the backdrop of COVID-19 pandemic which has been ravaging the world for more than a year. The Prime Minister called upon the global community to introspect on some pertinent questions in the present context.

The Prime Minister emphasized that global systems should adapt themselves, in order to address the underlying causes and not just the symptoms. The Prime Minister called for keeping humanity at the centre of our thoughts and action, and creating systems that address the problems of today and the challenges of tomorrow. The Prime Minister also elaborated upon India's pandemic response efforts, both domestically as well as in form of assistance to other countries. He called for joint efforts to meet the varied challenges posed by the pandemic and reiterated that India would share its strengths for global good.
